The scholarship is for \$1000 for one year and applicants can apply up to four times. The scholarship will go directly to your school to be used for your tuition and fees.

Eligibility

The criteria of the scholarship include participation in the club and academic achievement. To be eligible for the scholarship applicants must be a current member in the High Plains Paint Horse Club; been active in the club by showing at least 2 shows in the prior year or have volunteered at least 20 hours with the club in the last year.

Each applicant will have to provide the following:

1. This completed application
2. A typed double-spaced essay of up to 2500 words of your personal and educational goals.
3. Most recent Official High School or College transcript (send by the school to the club)
4. Proof of membership in the High Plains Paint Horse Club
5. (Optional) Letters of Recommendation

Submission

Your submission must include this application and your essay. Your transcript must come directly from the school.

- Mail your application and essay in a 9"x12" or larger envelope by U.S. Mail to the address below
- Have your High School or College send an official transcript to the address below
- Applications must be postmarked by April 1
